



Carmen Ortiz Mellet received her Ph. D. degree in Chemistry from the University of Seville (Spain) in 1984, where she was appointed Tenure Professor of Organic Chemistry in 1987. In 1990, she joined the group of Professor Jacques Defaye (CENG, Grenoble, France) to work in the synthesis of complex thiooligosaccharides. She came back again to Jacques Defaye's group in 1995 pursuing synthetic and supramolecular studies on cyclodextrins. Since 1998 she is responsible for the Carbohydrate Bioorganic Chemistry Group at the University of Seville, being promoted to Full Professor in 2008. Her research interest focuses on the study of the interactions of carbohydrates with other molecules and biomolecules, from drugs to enzymes, lectins and DNA. The laboratory also develops a research line on prebiotic oligosaccharides in collaboration with the Department of Pharmacology of the University of Granada (Spain).
